1 Masjid Alwi, Kangar

Coordinate: 6°26'27"N 100°11'52.4"E / 6.440861°N 100.197889°E

Masjid Alwi in Kangar, Perlis, is a historically significant mosque built between 1931 and 1933. It was funded by the government and Muslim traders. The construction involved Indian builders brought in by the British, as local craftsmen were not used. The mosque features a Mughal-style onion dome, reflecting colonial architectural influences. In 2018, Masjid Alwi was designated a national heritage site.

2 Wat Suwankhiri, Kampung Guar Musang, Kangar
